### DR. CHARLES E. KINSLEY

Dr. Charles E. "Chuck" Kinsley, V.M.D., 79, of Hallstead, PA entered into rest and was reunited with his beloved son, Mark, on October 4, 2024 with his loving wife at his side. Mark predeceased him on June 18, 2023.

Chuck is survived by his wife of 54 years, Sharon; daughter-in-law, Amy Kinsley; a grandson, Ti Szilagyi; a sister, Bobbi (Ronnie) Griffis; and numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family members.

Chuck graduated from Blue Ridge High School in 1963, Penn State in 1967, finally from the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine in 1971. He worked for Dr. Donald Sherwood in Binghamton, NY for seven years before returning home and opening Hometown Animal Hospital in 1978, which he operated until his retirement in 2006. Doctor Chuck was known for his expertise and his compassion for animals and their owners. He was an avid outdoorsman and member of the NRA, the Hallstead Rod and Gun Club, and the New Milford Rod and Gun Club. Chuck enjoyed educating and mentoring the younger generations. He was a member of the Community Methodist Church, Great Bend, PA.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m., Wednesday, October 9, 2024 at the Community Methodist Church, Great Bend, PA. Friends may call from 9-11, at the church, prior to the service.
