Daniel Howard Wages, 63, of New Milford, PA, left us for his heavenly home on September 10th, 2023.

The family moved back to New Milford because Daniel and Kathy wanted to raise their children near extended family and friends. Daniel started a second career with the U.S. Post Office, in Montrose before transferring to New Milford and retiring in 2019.

He loved spending time with his family, hunting with his children, and fishing with Alanna. During his childrens' Triplet's career, he could be found announcing in the tower being heralded as "The Voice of the Triplets". Daniel was well known as Mr. Fix-it, even if it meant three trips to the hardware store or several calls to unsuspecting friends for help who always answered. In his retirement, he enjoyed traveling to Hawaii, Florida, and Maine, and visiting various loved ones along the way. He will be sorely missed by his Wednesday Morning Breakfast Club.

He served the Lord he loved at the First United Methodist Church in New Milford, serving as Lay Leader for many years which placed him on most committees. Daniel was the delegate to the Annual Conference for many years. He also taught Junior High Sunday School and led the Junior High Youth Group for eight years. He was co-founder of the Feed My Sheep food pantry which he served for many years.

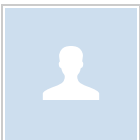
