Emily Ann Moss Darrow went to be with Jesus on May 8, 2022 at the age of 84, capping off a life filled with love for God, family, friends, and the community. Emily also enjoyed sports, coaching a Little League baseball team with her husband for more than a decade and cheering from the stands for years after that. She was strong and stubborn, she had a big personality and a bigger heart, and she will be sorely missed.

Emily was predeceased by her husband Milton (Mick) Darrow, sister Elizabeth Steadman and brother-in-law Donald, brother Ogden Moss and sister-in-law Effie, and brother John Moss and sister-in-law Bette. She is survived by her four children- Myrtle Anthony, Michelle Benites (husband James), Milton Darrow, and Melinda Darrow; six beloved grandchildren- Elizabeth Conklin, Anakin Major, Madisyn Anthony, and Jovita, Mercedes, and Eliana Benites; and several special nieces and nephews and grandnieces and
