Glenn "Nick" Wright Shreffler, Jr, 81, of Montrose, PA, passed away on November 8, 2024. Born on May 20, 1943, Glenn graduated from Dobbins High Technical School and then dedicated two years to serving in the Army, where he embraced the discipline and camaraderie that the military life offered.

Glenn was a devoted, loving husband, father and grandfather.

Following his military service, Glenn embarked on a successful career, initially with Eaton Yale and later with the Philadelphia Inquirer, as a machinist. He was highly respected for his work ethic and integrity.

Throughout his lifetime as a Phillies and Eagles fan, Glenn had some of his best memories attending games, watching games at home smiling and cheering every home run and touchdown brought to life by any game. He was more passionate than anybody regarding sports. He was a man of diverse interests. His love for hockey went beyond playing the sport until the age of 57. He also contributed as a coach and umpire for Basketball, Baseball, Football, Hockey and much more at the Torresdale Boys and Girls Club, earning the Man of the Year Award for his dedication.

In 2001 Glenn fulfilled his long time dream and purchased a home in Harford

PA where he could hunt his own land. Hunting was his passion.

On April 11, 2007 Glenn was inducted into the Knights of Columbus. His commitment to the Knights of Columbus was profound, where he served in Great Bend, PA as Grand Knight, Faithful Navigation, Comptroller and served 6 years as District Deputy while fulfilling his other knightly duties.

Glenn was a devout member of St Lawrence Church in Great Bend, actively participating in the community and spiritual life. His faith was a cornerstone of his existence, guiding him through his life's endeavors.

Glenn showed unconditional love to his wife and family and always told his wife he loved her. He was always a person you can count on, a good neighbor and didn't hesitate to help anyone in need.

Glenn is survived by his loving and devoted wife, Diana; children Glenn (Sonja), Michelle Runowich (Nick), Stacy, Brion, Theresa, Dawn Feeney (Tim); He is survived by 6 grandchildren, Jennifer, Katharina, Ryan, Kyle, Deanna, and John; and 5 great grandchildren Isabella, Robert, Ella Rae, Alana, and Jackson.

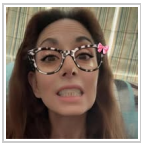

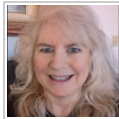
