JANET PAGE HARTT, passed away Thursday, April 27th 2023. She was the wife of Harold J. Hartt who passed in 2013; mother of Jerome P. Hartt and wife, Karen; grandmother of Victoria Page Hartt Salinkas, and husband, John; and great grandmother of John Jerome and Jakob Page Salinkas. Born in Susquehanna, PA in March 1928, daughter of E. Raymond and Pearl Ainey Page, she was a member of the North Jackson Methodist Church where she served as organist. A graduate of Bloomsburg University, she was head of the commercial department at Blue Ridge High School, New Milford and was a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International. She began her rewarding teaching career at Thompson High School. Janet was active in many civic organizations. She had been President of BPW, New Milford and achieved status as Grand Matron, Order of the Eastern Star. Along with her husband, she was also a People to People United States Agricultural Representative to Australia and

China. The most noteworthy role in her life was that as “yellow grandma” to Vikki. She was a generational coparent along with “yellow grampa” instilling love, nurturance, faith, and values that will pass on to the “boys”. Also surviving is a sister Ann and husband Don Lewis; sisters-in-law, Mary Hartt and Ruth Page. She was predeceased by a brother Miller Page; a sister, Marilyn Van Duren and husband Rev. John Van Duren. 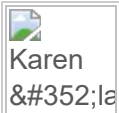

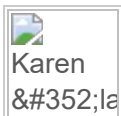

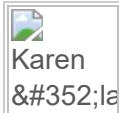
