He completed a Master's degree in environmental science from Oklahoma University in 1997. The majority of his employment was in positions that helped mitigate any environmental impact, the latest being in telecommunications as an independent contractor for NB+C.

Mark was a lover of all sports, especially hockey, and played for Maine-Endwell High School. He was an avid Yankees, Steelers, Carolina Hurricanes, and Sixers fan. He loved a good sports debate and banter with his close friends and especially with his brother-in-law, Joe. Mark also loved to cook, and prepared many meals for family and friends that he adored so much. The holiday meals and summer barbeque menus were carefully crafted and created with love.

Mark was best known for his love of all animals especially his beloved dogs Ember and Cloey. He loved nothing more than taking Emmy for miles long walks, and always insisted on both dogs sleeping in bed at night, much to Amy's lighthearted dismay. Mark had a passion for nature and for being outdoors. He spent many hours hunting later in life due to the influence of his father. He took great pride in his yard, keeping a garden and planting seasonal flowers.

Mark considered going "up home" to his parent's house with Amy and their dogs one of life's great pleasures. It was a getaway for him, and countless hours were spent sitting on the deck with his mother and father, taking in the natural beauty that surrounded their home. Mark was raised to be the man he is by two incredible parents who loved him dearly.

There are many words that can be used to describe Mark, and those who knew him well and loved him would agree that he was kind, opinionated, smart, loving, witty, and hard working. Mark loved all of God's creatures and people; his heart was closed to no one. His love for his wife, Amy, was epic and prolific. In the throes of battling cholangiocarcinoma, his only worry was who would take over caring for her and for his pets. Not everyone gets to have a soulmate; Mark and Amy both did in each other.

Mark's inner light and humanity will not soon be forgotten. It is easy to understand why so many people truly loved him, and why his friendships were decades long. Mark would want everyone to remember him with a smile, and to be kind and gentle with one another. He often said tomorrow is promised to

nobody, and to truly live life on one's own terms.
