Maybelle A. Oakley, 92, of New Milford, PA went home to be with the Lord on December 5, 2012. She was predeceased by her husband, Leland T. Oakley in 1961, a daughter Deborah Heatherman, a son, Gerald J. Oakley, and daughter-in-law, Phyllis Oakley.

Maybelle is survived by two children, Joan Oakley and David and Susan Oakley; 11 grandchildren; 24 great grandchildren; two great great grandchildren; two sisters, Grace Ives and Bernice and Max Warner; and several nieces and nephews.

Born in Binghamton, Maybelle moved to Harford in the 1930s. She married her high school sweetheart in 1939. They operated a dairy farm in Harford until 1942 when they purchased the Oakley Farmstead. Maybelle was a 4H leader, involved with Dairyman's League, and a member of the New Milford Grange, for many years. She was very active in the South New Milford Baptist Church, serving in various positions; Sunday School Teacher and Superintendent, Deaconess, Choir Director, Prayer Warrior, Correspondent and encourager, Helping Hands Circle, Awana, and providing assistance with dinners. She served as a committee member of Child Evangelism Fellowship, Montrose, for many years.

A funeral service will be held on Monday, December 10, 2012, at Noon at the South New Milford Baptist Church with Pastor James Camacho and Pastor Larry Thomas.
