CINCINNATI OH – Richard Teofil Kowalewski, 93, formerly a resident of Hallstead, PA for over 60 years, died on May 1, 2024, in Cincinnati OH. He especially enjoyed spending time with his family (including extended family), bowling, working in his yard, caring for his pets, watching

baseball or softball and he loved a mechanical challenge. In retirement, he was often found happily “puttering” in his garage or basement.
