



## Roger A. Zurn

Roger A. Zurn, age 85, of York, formerly of Hallstead, Susquehanna County, died, December 30, 2020 at Misericordia Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in York. He was the husband of the late Trudy (Wilcox) Zurn.
