



Stephen W. Esposito

Stephen Esposito, 71, of Hallstead Pennsylvania, born and raised on Cedar Knolls Road in Whippany New Jersey, went into rest on August 8th, 2024. He was the son of the late Michael P. Esposito and Margery Hinds Esposito and is predeceased by his brother Daniel.

Stephen is survived by his three sons Stephen J. Esposito, Timothy D. (Jessica R.) Esposito and Lewis W. Esposito; his two grandchildren Elliott J. Esposito and Meadow M. Esposito; his four siblings Michael, David, Laura, and Lisa; and several nieces and nephews.

“Stevie” was a self employed auto mechanic specializing in transmissions. He ran the business of Ledgewood Transmission which was later renamed Hallstead Transmission. He served his country from 1971-1977 as a drill sergeant in the U.S. Army Reserves at Fort Dix and was honorably discharged. He also served as the Mayor of Hallstead for a few years.

An avid outdoorsmen, few could revel in the trophies on his wall, though many could appreciate them. In his younger days, he raced dirt tracks with his car, “The Flying Zero.” Steve had a life full of many experiences and adventures, and those who knew him were sure to hear about them. He did it his way.

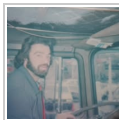
