William “Bill” Everett James Smith, 82, passed away peacefully on September 21, 2025, with his family by his side. Born in Detroit, Michigan, on April 20, 1943, to William James and Ruth Hafer Smith, Bill's life was marked by service, humor, love, and a deep connection to family and friends.

After graduating from Grosse Pointe South High School, Bill enlisted in the United States Army. Twenty years ago, Bill married Shirley Osborne Smith, the love of his life.

Together, they created a warm and joyful home, sharing their love of family, travel, and their cherished dog, Angus, who will miss him dearly.

Bill was a man of many passions. He loved to travel, enjoyed animals, and had a wicked sense of humor that could brighten any room. Bill had a knack for finding the perfect gift for those he cared about, and he was known for his culinary skills, particularly his legendary BBQ, in which he took great pride. As much as he loved cooking for others, Bill was equally passionate about experiencing great food from all walks of life.

Above all, Bill was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, uncle, and friend. He was a source of wisdom, laughter, and counsel to many who valued his intelligence, kindness, and humor. His absence will be deeply felt by all who knew him.
